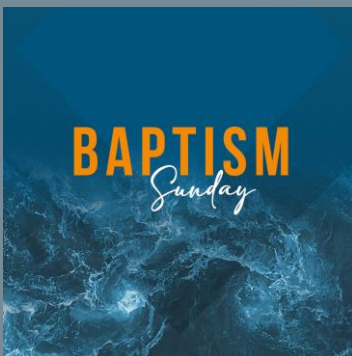

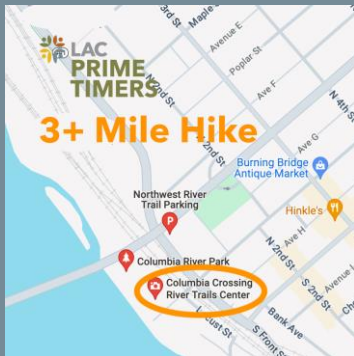
LAC PRIMETIMERS | LUNCH AND CONCERT
